

Total launches recycling project in Gauteng

TOTAL has just launched a pilot recycling project in Gauteng. The project includes 10 public recycling points situated at local service station sites:

2. TOTAL Sandton Drive
3. TOTAL Douglasdale
4. TOTAL Village
5. TOTAL Northriding
6. TOTAL Golden Harvest
7. TOTAL Rangeview
8. TOTAL Helderkruijn
9. TOTAL Constantia Kloof
10. TOTAL Fairland

The aim of the project is to encourage environmental awareness within the communities surrounding our sites and to create user friendly drop off points for residents in the area. TOTAL service stations are always well lit, are open around the clock, and as such they present safe and convenient venues for the facilities. Waste streams that can be accommodated include Paper /Cardboard, Plastic, Glass and Cans.

The recycling initiative is in line with TOTAL's positive attitude towards conservation. Toward's achieving the goal of being a good corporate citizen TOTAL embraces the concept of social responsibility and through this project it is hoped that as more people begin recycling a culture of caring for the environment will grow.
